

2026 Garden Plot Registration Process

Garden Plot Renewals:

Plot renewal emails will go out to eligible gardeners beginning on January 15th. The renewal period for returning gardeners to complete the registration is January 15th - January 31st. After January 31st, unregistered plots will be made available to those on the Community Gardens waitlist. Beginning at 9am on February 12th Growing Gardens will offer unregistered plots to waitlisted gardeners, beginning with the first gardener on the waitlist and continuing down the waitlist until all remaining plots are filled. Eligible waitlisted individuals will be sent a link to register for available plots and given three days to do so. This rolling enrollment will continue until all plots are filled.

New Gardeners:

Individuals wishing to garden in the community garden program in 2026 may add their name to the New Gardener Wait List. Growing Gardens fills open plots through this waitlist.

Reduced Rate Plots:

Any gardeners (renewing or new) who would like to register for a plot at the reduced rate must take the following actions:

1. Email info@growinggardens.org for more information and the link to the 2026 Community Garden Reduced Rate Application
2. Provide verification paperwork to show that they qualify for the reduced rate. Examples include: copy of Medicaid card, proof of residence in public housing, proof of disability (SSI, SSDI, or letter from an agency or physician.)
